Quick Start Guide

Launch for Windows

To get to work with ACS Assistant, follow these steps:

1. Extract the archive to a folder.

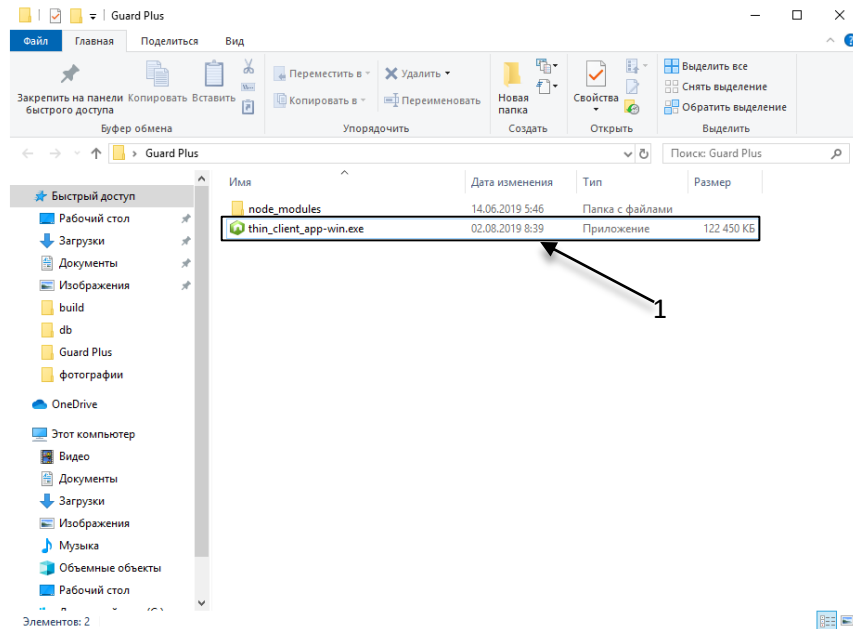


Fig. 1 ACS Assistant program launch

2. Open the program folder and run the file ***thin_client_app-win.exe*** (1 at Fig. 1).

3. After that, the program terminal opens, and then a tab in a browser opens automatically.
4. If the tab did not open, go to a browser and enter in the address bar *localhost:5870/index.html*.


Launch for Linux

There are three options to start working with ACS Assistant:

1. To run the program in the background, it is necessary:
 - a. extract the file from the archive and open the program folder
 - b. then double-click on the file ***thin_client_app-linux***
 - c. in this case, the program runs in the background (program terminal is not opened)
 - d. open a browser and enter in the address bar *localhost:5870/index.html*
2. Launch through terminal:
 - a. open a terminal in the program folder
 - b. enter *./thin_client_app-linux* and click *enter*

- c. open a browser and enter in the address bar *localhost:5870/index.html*
3. Run and configure the program through PM2 <http://pm2.keymetrics.io/> (in this case, auto start of the program is possible).

To log in, enter Username **root** and Password **root** (Fig. 2), login parameters can be changed (see *ACS Assistant User Manual*).
